The Executive Committee discussed ISACo training programs and the desire to avoid conflicting with newly-elected county official trainings being offered by other organizations in 2019. The committee discussed the prospect of offering training opportunities for county officials in 2020.

The committee discussed ISACo's new county official database and weekly email newsletter. The committee is pleased with the newsletter and the interest shown by recipients as tracked by ISACo staff.

# **LEGISLATIVE REPORT**

The committee briefly discussed a request from Board member and Tazewell County Board Chairman David Zimmerman for ISACo to support legislation that will be introduced to allow permissive authority for county boards to separate audit and accounting functions. Executive Director McCoy indicated his understanding that the bill is being introduced on behalf of Kankakee County. The issue has been added to the Board of Directors' agenda to be discussed on February 8, 2019.
